Go beyond playing every song the same way by adding colour, variation and interest to your playing through dynamics, articulation and tonal control.

Digits

The PIMA system

Strumming with different digits or different combinations creates different tones and colours

P flesh –**soft, mellow**

I nail –**crisp, strong**

I flesh –**delicate, gentle**

Rake (all but P) -
energetic, powerful

Pulgar – P

Indice – I

Media – M

Anular – A



Position

Strumming/picking where string tension differs affects the tone

Sul pont – **metallic, harsh**

Sul tasto – **bright, vibrant**

Dynamics

mf – mezzo forte
(moderately loud)

f – forte (loud)

p – piano (quiet)

mp – mezzo piano
(moderately quiet)

Crescendo

Getting louder



Diminuendo

Pauses

Pausing at important points
can highlight/spotlight
significant emotional beats.

Between sections/phrases

**Breath, calm,
contemplative**

Before finishing a phrase

Suspense, anticipation



Tempo

Adagio

Slow, sensitive

Allegro

Fast, brisk

Accelerando

Getting faster

Relenting, driving

Decelerando

Getting slower

Dying, lingering

Rubato


Speeding up before slowing
